CHAPTER 206

- AN ACT to renumber and amend 346.88 (3); and to create 346.88 (3) (b) of the statutes, relating to obstructing the view of an operator of a motor vehicle.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 346.88 (3) of the statutes is renumbered 346.88 (3) (a) and amended to read:

346.88 (3) (a) No person shall * * * drive any motor vehicle * * *

with any sign, poster or other nontransparent material upon the front windshield, front side wings * * *, side windows in the driver's compartment or rear * * * window of such vehicle other than a certificate or other * * * sticker issued by order of a governmental agency. Such permitted sticker shall not cover more than 15 square inches of glass surface and shall be placed in the lower left-hand corner of the windshield; the left corner being on the driver's left when seated behind the wheel.

SECTION 2. 346.88 (3) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

346.88 (3) (b) No person shall drive any motor vehicle upon a highway with any object so placed or suspended in or upon the vehicle so as to obstruct the driver's clear view through the front windshield or rear window, but signal lamps used by emergency vehicles shall not be considered a violation of this section.
