CHAPTER 217

AN ACT to create 174.055 of the statutes, relating to exempting "Seeing Eye" dogs from dog license tax.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

174.055 of the statutes is created to read:

174.055 EXEMPTION OF "SEEING EYE" OR LEADER DOGS FOR THE BLIND. Every dog specially trained to lead blind persons shall be exempt from dog license tax and every taxpayer owning such dog shall annually receive a free dog license from the local collecting officer upon application therefor,
