CHAPTER 232

AN ACT to amend 69.26 (4) of the statutes, relating to vital statistics informant fees of full or part-time physicians of municipalities or counties during the course of their public employment.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

69.26 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

69.26 (4) The state registrar shall annually certify to the county clerks of the several counties, the number of births, fetal deaths, deaths and marriages registered with the names of the persons reporting and the amounts due each at the rate fixed herein, whereupon the county clerk shall certify such amounts to the county treasurer for payment to the persons entitled thereto. Any full-time or part-time physician or medical examiner of any municipality or county who during the course of his employment completes a certificate of birth or death shall be required to note the nature of his employment thereon and the state registrar shall exclude said certificate from the annual certification to the county clerk.
