CHAPTER 239

AN ACT to create 66.40 (26) of the statutes, relating to manner of dissolving local housing authority when its usefulness is ended.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.40 (26) of the statutes is created to read:

66.40 (26) DISSOLUTION OF HOUSING AUTHORITY. Any housing authority may be dissolved upon adoption of an ordinance or resolution by the council or village board concerned declaring that the need therefor no longer exists, that all projects under such authority's jurisdiction have been disposed of, that there are no outstanding obligations or contracts and that no further business remains to be transacted by such authority.
