CHAPTER 307

AN ACT authorizing the board of regents of the state colleges to sell stateowned lands therein described located in the cities of Stevens Point and Platteville, and crediting the proceeds to the appropriation made by section 20.760 of the statutes and authorizing said department to expend therefrom amounts for paying the expenses of the sale.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

The secretary of the board of regents of state colleges, with the approval of the governor, is authorized to sell and convey that portion of the state-owned lands which are now a part of the premises of the Wisconsin state colleges described as follows:

"The east 30 feet of the northeast quarter of the southeast quarter of section 29, and that part of the east 30 feet of the southeast quarter, of the southeast quarter lying north of Fourth avenue; all in section 29, township 24 north, range 8 east, city of Stevens Point, Portage county, Wisconsin, and lot 10 of the original plat of the village (now city) of Platteville, excepting 16 feet off the north end thereof, Grant county, Wisconsin" under such terms, conditions and covenants as the secretary shall determine; and the proceeds of such sales shall be deposited in the general fund and credited to the appropriation made by section 20.760 of the statutes and the board of regents of state colleges is authorized to pay the expenses of such sales out of said appropriation.
