CHAPTER 308

AN ACT to amend 346.52 (2); and to create 349.13 (2) (f) of the statutes, relating to permitting parking on near side of highways adjacent to schools in cities of the first class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 346.52 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

346.52 (2) During the hours of 7:30 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. during school days, no person shall stop or leave any vehicle standing, whether temporarily or otherwise, upon the near side of a through highway adjacent to a school house used for any children below the ninth grade. If the highway adjacent to such schoolhouse is not a through highway, the operator of a vehicle may stop upon the near side thereof during such hours, provided such stopping is temporary and only for the purpose of receiving or discharging passengers. This subsection shall not apply to cities of the first class when the common council thereof by ordinance permits parking on the near side of specified highways or streets adjacent to schoolhouses during specified hours.

SECTION 2. 349.13 (2) (f) of the statutes is created to read:

349.13 (2) (f) Permit parking on the near side of specified high-ways or streets adjacent to schoolhouses in cities of the first class during specified hours when the common council of any such city by ordinance so directs.
