CHAPTER 312

AN ACT to create 346.57 (4) (i) of the statutes, relating to speed limits on streets in city or village park or recreation areas.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

346.57 (4) (i) of the statutes is created to read:

346.57 (4) (i) 15 miles per hour on any city or village street, except a state trunk highway or connecting street, within, contiguous to or adjacent to a public park or recreation area when children are going to or from or are playing within such area, when the local authority has enacted an ordinance regulating such traffic and has properly marked such area with movable traffic signals which conform to rules of the state highway commission erected at such points as said authority deems necessary and at those points on the streets concerned where persons traversing the same would enter such area from an area where a different speed limit is in effect.
