CHAPTER 328

AN ACT to amend 36.15 of the statutes, relating to optional instruction in military science and tactics at the university.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

36.15 of the statutes is amended to read:

36.15 All schools and colleges of the university shall, in their respective departments and class exercises, be open without distinction to

students of both sexes; and every able-bodied male student therein, except those granted exemption under rules * * * prescribed by the board of regents, shall during his freshman and sophomore years of attendance receive instruction in military science and tactics and that such instruction in military science and tactics shall be optional to such male students when the faculty so determines and the board of regents approves.
