## **CHAPTER 392**

- AN ACT to create 40.30 (10m) (e) and (f) of the statutes, relating to physical and medical examinations required of persons whose work brings them in contact with school children.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - 40.30 (10m) (e) and (f) of the statutes are created to read:
- 40.30 (10m) (e) County superintendents, county supervising teachers and special teachers, school psychologists, school social workers and other personnel working for the county in public schools shall be required by the county board education committee to have physical examinations under the conditions of employment in par. (a). The cost of such examinations shall be paid out of the funds allocated to the office of the county superintendent.
- (f) All employes of the state department of public instruction whose work brings them into contact with school children or with employes of school districts are required to have physical examinations under the conditions of employment in par. (a).
