## **CHAPTER 414**

AN ACT to amend 321.01 (1) of the statutes, relating to the register in probate approving county court bonds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

321.01 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

321.01 (1) All bonds required by law to be taken in or by order of the county court shall be for such sum and with such sureties as the court shall direct, except when otherwise provided by law. Such bonds shall be for the security and benefit of all persons interested and shall be taken to the judge of the county court, and in any county court having more than one judge, shall run to all of the judges of said court, except where they are required by law to be taken to the adverse party. No such bond shall be deemed sufficient unless it shall have been examined and approved by the judge or the register in probate and his approval indorsed thereon in writing and signed by him; but his failure so to do shall not render the bond void.
