CHAPTER 432

- AN ACT to amend 62.09 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to eligibility to membership on city boards of police and fire commissioners.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - 62.09 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 62.09 (2) (b) Except as otherwise provided by statute, no alderman shall during the term for which he is elected be eligible to any appointive city office but he shall be eligible for any elective city office. The council may be represented on city boards and commissions, except the board of police and fire commissioners, where no additional remuneration is paid alderman representatives on such a body, and the governing body may fix the tenure of such representatives notwithstanding any other statutory provision.
