CHAPTER 457

- AN ACT to amend 97.25 (2) (h) 2; and to create 97.25 (2) (hm) and (hn) of the statutes, relating to pesticides, food additives and other substances injurious to health.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
 - SECTION 1. 97.25 (2) (h) 2 of the statutes is amended to read:
- 97.25 (2) (h) 2. When the addition of a poison or deleterious substance is required in the production thereof or cannot be avoided by good manufacturing practice, * * * then the quantity therein or thereon * * * shall conform to such an extent as is necessary for the protection of public health within the meaning of the federal food, drug and cosmetic act (21 USC 301-392);
- SECTION 2. 97.25 (2) (hm) and (hn) of the statutes are created to read:
- 97.25 (2) (hm) If it bears or contains any pesticide chemical, as defined in the federal food, drug and cosmetic act (21 USC 301-392), which is unsafe within the meaning of said act;
- (hn) If it is or it bears or contains any food additive, as defined in the federal food, drug and cosmetic act (21 USC 301-392), which is unsafe within the meaning of said act;
