CHAPTER 47

AN ACT to amend 6.22 (1) (g) of the statutes, relating to assisting certain handicapped persons to vote.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

6.22 (1) (g) of the statutes is amended to read:

6.22 (1) (g) A voter, who declares to the presiding officer that he is unable to read, or that by reason of physical disability he is unable to mark his ballot, can have assistance of 2 election officers in marking same, to be chosen by the voter; and if he declares that he is * * * *visually handicapped*, he may * * * *have anyone assist him in marking his ballot or operating a voting machine.* The presiding officer may administer an oath in his discretion, as to such person's disability.
