CHAPTER 472

AN ACT to amend 20.670 (72) (b) of the statutes, relating to sale of buildings and site of the Wisconsin school for boys at Waukesha.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

20.670 (72) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.670 (72) (b) The state department of public welfare may sell the buildings and site *including all farm lands* of the present *Wisconsin* school for boys if the new institution is constructed on another site, and all moneys received by the department of public welfare from the sale of the property at the site of the present *Wisconsin* school for boys and all other unexpended moneys appropriated by the legislature for the improvement of the present *Wisconsin* school for boys are appropriated to the state building trust fund.
