CHAPTER 507

AN ACT to amend 20.650 (31) (a); and to create 39.02 (5c) of the statutes, relating to maintenance charges against participants of institutes and training programs and visitors at the state schools for the deaf and visually handicapped, and appropriation of moneys received for food and lodging of participants in institutes and training programs and visitors at the state schools for the deaf and visually handicapped.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.650 (31) (a) of the statutes is amended to read:

20.650 (31) (a) Maintenance credits. All moneys received in reimbursement for services rendered institutional employes, participants in institutes and training programs and visitors at the state schools for the deaf and the visually handicapped pursuant to s. 39.02 (5b) and (5c) to be refunded to the appropriation made by * * * this subsection and to be used for materials and expense. Such reimbursements shall be accumulated in an account named " * * * maintenance credits".

SECTION 2. 39.02 (5c) of the statutes is created to read:

39.02 (5c) MAINTENANCE CHARGES FOR OTHERS. All moneys received from participants of institutes and training programs and from visitors at the state schools for the deaf and the visually handicapped for meals and living quarters shall be paid within one week after receipt into the general fund and are to be credited to the appropriation provided for this purpose by ch. 20.
