## CHAPTER 567

AN ACT to amend 13.45 (2) and (3) (e) and (i) of the statutes, relating to the extension of a joint legislative committee on physical plant maintenance.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

13.45 (2) and (3) (e) and (i) of the statutes are amended to read:

13.45 (2) The joint legislative committee on physical plant maintenance is created under the legislative council consisting of one senator and 2 assemblymen who possess substantial experience in construction and related fields, appointed as are standing committees in the respective houses. The committee shall expire May 1, \* \* \* 1961, and members are not disqualified because they cease to be legislators. The committee shall elect a chairman and secretary from among its membership. The members shall be reimbursed for their necessary expenses as provided in s. 20.530 (1) (c).

(3) (e) Consider the adequacy of the \* \* \* policing of the capitol and capitol grounds and make recommendations for any improvement.

(i) Report its findings, conclusions and recommendations to the legislative council on or before November 1, \* \* \* 1960.
