CHAPTER 575

AN ACT to create 209.04 (7) (e) of the statutes, relating to exempting fur storers from obtaining insurance agent licenses.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

209.04 (7) (e) of the statutes is created to read:

209.04 (7) (e) Fur storers. Persons engaged in the business of fur storage who deliver to their storage customers certificates or policies providing insurance on specified furs, garments trimmed with fur or other garments accepted for storage and who collect the premium therefor, provided they receive no compensation for such service.
