## CHAPTER 599

- AN ACT to amend 14.525 (2) of the statutes, relating to directing the attorney general to co-operate with the federal trade commission in certain matters.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - 14.525 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:
- 14.525 (2) The assistant attorney general in charge of antitrust investigations and prosecutions is to co-operate actively with the antitrust division of the U.S. department of justice in everything that concerns monopolistic practices in Wisconsin, and also to co-operate actively with the state department of agriculture in the work which this agency is carrying on under s. 100.20 of the marketing law with regard to monopolistic practices in the field of agriculture and with the federal trade commission on matters arising in or affecting Wisconsin which pertain to its jurisdiction.
