## CHAPTER 632

AN ACT to create 66.906 (1e) of the statutes, relating to the coverage under the Wisconsin retirement fund of de facto officers appointed after age 65.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.906 (1e) of the statutes is created to read:

66.906 (1e) DE FACTO OFFICERS. Any state officer, heretofore or hereafter appointed, who has passed age 65 on the date of appointment, who has been confirmed by the senate when required by law, and for whom no proper formal notice required under sub. (1) (a) has been filed is entitled to all salary and to benefits under ss. 66.90 to 66.919 for the period for which he serves as a de facto officer just as though such formal notice or notices under sub. (1) (a) had been filed and notwithstanding that said state officer had terminated his employment prior to the effective date of this subsection.
