CHAPTER 638

AN ACT to amend 30.71 of the statutes, as created by chapter 505, laws of 1959, relating to toilets on boats at the Wisconsin Dells.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

30.71 of the statutes, as created by chapter 505, laws of 1959, is amended to read:

30.71 No person shall maintain or operate upon the inland waters of this state, except Lake Winnebago * * *, the Mississippi river and the Wisconsin river for 15 miles above and below the dam at Wisconsin Dells, any boat which is equipped with a toilet unless such toilet is sealed or otherwise rendered inoperative so that no human wastes can be discharged into such waters. "Inland waters" means the waters defined as inland waters by s. 29.01 (4).
