CHAPTER 680

AN ACT to amend 29.174 (1) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 520, laws of 1959, relating to applying the ban on deer hunting licenses dated after the season starts only to licenses for hunting with guns.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.174 (1) of the statutes, as amended by chapter 520, laws of 1959, is amended to read:

29.174 (1) There shall be established and maintained, as hereinafter provided, such open and close seasons for the several species of fish and game, and such bag limits, size limits, rest days and conditions governing the taking of fish and game as will conserve the fish and game supply and insure the citizens of this state continued opportunities for good fishing, hunting and trapping. Except for the Apostle Islands other than Madeline Island no deer hunting license shall be valid in a designated area if dated on or after the opening date for the gun deer season for such area unless the open season in an area overlaps the open season in another area in which case deer hunting licenses dated before the opening date in any area shall be valid in any other area during the period such seasons overlap.
