CHAPTER 78

AN ACT to amend 269.34 (4) of the statutes, relating to service by mail.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

269.34 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

269.34 (4) Service may be made by mailing such copy where the person making the service and the person on whom it is made reside in different places between which there is a communication by mail. Service by mail is complete upon mailing. The copy of the paper to be served must be properly enclosed in a postpaid * * * envelope and must be addressed to the person on whom it is to be served at his proper post-office address * * * . The envelope may bear the sender's name and address and a request to the postal officers * * * for the return thereof in case of nondelivery to the person addressed.
