CHAPTER 108

AN ACT to amend 348.05 (3) of the statutes, relating to moving overwidth farm machinery.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

348.05 (3) of the statutes is amended to read:

348.05 (3) Notwithstanding any provision of this section to the contrary farm tractors exceeding 9 feet in width and all other farm machinery and implements of husbandry exceeding 8 feet in width may be moved, towed, hauled, by truck or trailer, or in any other manner or by any other means, over the highways of this state by dealers or farmers or for purposes of repair without special permit between the hours of 7 a.m. and 4 p.m. on Mondays through Thursdays and from 7 a.m. to 11:30 a.m. on Fridays, but not earlier than one-half hour before sunrise or later than one-half hour after sunset on any day. Such overwidth machinery shall not be moved on any Wisconsin highway which is part of the national system of interstate highways without special permit.
