## CHAPTER 289

- AN ACT to renumber 66.047; and to create 66.047 (2) of the statutes, relating to interference with public service structures and notification to public utility of proposed work which might affect facilities serving the public.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:
  - SECTION 1. 66.047 of the statutes is renumbered 66.047 (1).

SECTION 2. 66.047 (2) of the statutes is created to read:

66.047 (2) Every person intending to excavate, erect a building or structure, make substantial structural changes, or wreck a building or structure shall, before commencing the work, give at least 3 days' notice, not counting Saturdays, Sundays and legal holidays, of such intention in writing to all public utilities whose facilities for serving the public might be affected thereby.
