CHAPTER 52

AN ACT to amend 32.05 (1) of the statutes, relating to the county highway committee making orders, laying out, relocating and improving highways, streets, alleys or airports when authorized by the county board.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

32.05 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

32.05 (1) The state highway commission, turnpike commission, county board of supervisors (or the county highway committee when so authorized by said board), county expressway commission, city council, village board or state aeronautics commission shall make an order providing for the laying out, relocation and improvement of the public highway, street, alley or airport which shall be known as the relocation order. This order shall include a map or plat showing the old and new locations and the lands and interests required. A copy of the order shall, within 10 days after its issue, be filed with the county clerk of the county wherein the lands are located.
