CHAPTER 122

AN ACT to amend 945.01 (2) (b) of the statutes, relating to the definition of "consideration" in the prohibition of certain contests.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

945.01 (2) (b) of the statutes is amended to read:

945.01 (2) (b) "Consideration" in this subsection means anything which is a commercial or financial advantage to the promoter or a disadvantage to any participant, but does not include any advantage to the promoter or disadvantage to any participant caused when any participant learns from newspapers, magazines and other periodicals, radio or television where to send his name and address to the promoter.
