## CHAPTER 155

AN ACT to create 140.05 (14) of the statutes, relating to the powers and duties of the board to make studies and accept grants therefor.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

140.05 (14) of the statutes is created to read:

140.05 (14) The board may conduct investigations, studies, experiments and research pertaining to any public health problems which are a cause or potential cause of morbidity or mortality and methods for the precause or potential cause of morbidity or mortality and methods for the prevention or amelioration of such public health problems. For the conduct of such investigations, studies, experiments and research, the board may on behalf of the state accept funds from any public or private agency, organization or person. It may conduct such investigations, studies, experiments and research independently or by contract or in co-operation with any public or private agency, organization or person including any political subdivision of the state.
