## CHAPTER 184

AN ACT to amend 59.87 (2) of the statutes, relating to the composition of the county committee on agriculture.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.87 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

59.87 (2) COMMITTEE ON AGRICULTURE. If the county board of supervisors determines to establish a co-operative extension service, it shall create a committee on agriculture consisting of the chairman of the board \* \* \* and 3 or more other members of the board selected by the

board \* \* \*. One of the members thus selected shall be a supervisor from a village or city and the vocation of a majority of the \* \* \* remaining members of the committee shall be agriculture in counties where membership with such qualifications is available. The county board may select as an additional member of the committee the county superintendent of schools or any other public school administrator resident in the county. The members of the committee on agriculture, including such additional member, if one has been selected, shall receive such compensation and expenses as the board \* \* \* determines under the authority of s. 59.15 (2) (c) and (3). The committee on agriculture shall meet at such intervals as is deemed necessary to properly carry out its functions and responsibilities.
