CHAPTER 202

AN ACT to amend 341.26 (4) of the statutes, relating to truck licensing. The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 341. 26 (4) of the statutes is amended to read:

341.26 (4) Except for those vehicles that qualify for registration under sub. (1) (a) to (e), any motor vehicle, trailer or semitrailer, if operated empty, or used exclusively in transporting the equipment of the owner to or from a certain location over the highways, when such operation at the location is exclusively for grading, ditching or excavating or when such equipment is used exclusively for seasonal hauling of carnival rides and equipment, shall be registered at one-fourth of the fee specified in s. 341.25 (2) for vehicles or combinations of vehicles of the same gross weight.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill in accordance with section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
