

CHAPTER 233

AN ACT to amend 62.13 (10) (h) 1 of the statutes, relating to the administration of a pension system which has been part of a town that has consolidated with a city of the first class.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

62.13 (10) (h) 1 of the statutes is amended to read:

62.13 (10) (h) 1. Notwithstanding any provisions of law to the contrary, whenever a body corporate within a county having a population of * * * 500,000 or more consolidates or has consolidated with a city of the first class and such body corporate maintains or has maintained a pension system for firemen under ch. 60 or * * * 62, the common council of such city of the first class may by charter ordinance provide that the duties of the pension board or board of trustees formerly governing such pension system of the body corporate shall be assumed by * * * a retirement board of the city of the first class in the manner determined by the common council of such city when so directed by charter ordinance.
