CHAPTER 259

AN ACT authorizing and directing the state department of public welfare to convey to the town of Allouez, Brown county, a part of the state reformatory land for street and highway purposes.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. The director of the state department of public welfare is authorized and directed to convey to the town of Allouez, Brown county, for street and highway purposes, the following state reformatory land:

All that part of P.C. (private claim) 19, ESFR (east side of the Fox river) in the town of Allouez, Brown county, Wisconsin, described as follows:

"Beginning at a point on the easterly line of Webster avenue where the easterly line of Webster avenue intersects the southerly line of P.C. 19, ESFR, and the northerly line of P.C. 20, ESFR, thence easterly along said common line between P.C. 19 and P.C. 20 571.65 feet to the westerly line of Beaumont street; thence southerly along the westerly line of Beaumont street 35 feet; thence westerly parallel to the common line between P.C. 19 and P.C. 20 571.65 feet to the easterly line of Webster avenue; thence northerly along the easterly line of Webster avenue 35 feet to the point of beginning."

SECTION 2. The conveyance of said land to the town of Allouez shall be by appropriate deed or other instrument of transfer executed by the director of the state department of public welfare. The instrument of transfer shall be conditioned upon and restrict use of the premises for street and highway purposes.
