CHAPTER 286

AN ACT to create 90.02 (1) (j) of the statutes, relating to the definition of a legal fence

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

90.02 (1) (j) of the statutes is created to read:

90.02 (1) (j) A fence not less than 48 inches high of 4 or more barbed wires spaced evenly on a steel post of any diameter or on a wood post at least 3 inches in diameter, which posts are spaced one rod or less apart. Existing fences of a lesser standard are legal until they are rebuilt, repaired or replaced.
