## CHAPTER 303

AN ACT to amend 66.906 (1) (c) of the statutes, relating to compulsory retirement.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.906 (1) (c) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.906 (1) (c) Subject to the provisions of par. (a) a participating employe who is a policeman, fireman, state traffic officer, state motor vehicle inspector, state conservation warden, state forest ranger or other state conservation department employe subject to the 5 per cent normal contribution rate, county undersheriff, deputy sheriff or traffic policeman who has attained age 60 or more on the effective date for that participating municipality shall be retired at the end of his first calendar quarter year as a participating employe. Any such participating employe who attains age 60 shall be retired at the end of the calendar quarter year in which such age is attained. Notwithstanding the foregoing provisions of this paragraph, they shall not be construed to require the retirement of any participating employe prior to January 1, \* \* \* 1966, who had not retired prior to August 5, 1959.
