## CHAPTER 323

AN ACT to amend 14.75 (1) of the statutes, relating to the composition of the commission on interstate co-operation.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 14.75 (1) of the statutes is amended to read:

14.75 (1) There is created a commission on interstate co-operation to consist of 3 senators and 3 assemblymen, who shall be appointed as are standing committees in the respective houses at the commencement of each regular session of the legislature, the majority and minority leaders of each house, the president pro tempore of the senate, the speaker of the assembly and 3 state officials to be designated by the governor. The governor shall serve as an ex officio, nonvoting member of the commission. Vacancies in legislative members shall be filled in the same manner as original appointments are made, and subject to s. 13.095 (3), but all vacancies \* \* in public members shall be filled by the governor. Members shall continue to serve until their successors are appointed. The commission shall elect one of its members chairman and one secretary. The provisions of s. 14.69 (6) shall apply. Alternates to attend specific meetings may be chosen as are persons to fill vacancies, and their terms shall expire when their mission is accomplished.

Section 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill in accordance with section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
