CHAPTER 330

AN ACT to amend 30.70 of the statutes, relating to the restrictions on skin divers.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

30.70 of the statutes is amended to read:

30.70 No person shall engage in underwater diving or swimming with the use of self-contained underwater breathing apparatus unless the approximate location of such diving or swimming is distinctly marked by a flag designed so as to have one diagonal white stripe on a red background, and be of a size and height above the water so as to be clearly apparent at a distance of 100 yards under normal conditions. Except in the case of emergency anyone engaging in such diving or swimming shall not rise near or to the surface of the water except within a radius of 50 feet from such flag. No person engaged in such diving or swimming shall interfere with the operations of anyone fishing in the immediate area. This statute shall not apply to the Great Lakes or the waters of Green Bay.
