CHAPTER 350

AN ACT to create 57.15 of the statutes, relating to the state public welfare department receiving for probation persons convicted in certain courts in populous counties.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

57.15 of the statutes is created to read:

57.15 DEPARTMENT MAY TAKE PROBATIONS FROM MIL-WAUKEE COUNTY. The department may, upon request of any court or any branch thereof having jurisdiction under s. 57.025, receive for supervision outside of any county to which s. 57.025 is applicable, probationers convicted in such county and shall have the same custody and control of such persons as it has over other probationers in custody of the department.
