CHAPTER 367

AN ACT to create 29.573 (7) of the statutes, relating to creating civil liability for trespassing on a pheasant preserve.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

29.573 (7) of the statutes is created to read:

29.573 (7) Any person other than the licensee, his agents or persons having permission from the licensee who are otherwise qualified under ch. 29 to hunt thereon, who hunts or shoots pheasants upon any lands described in any such license, is liable for all damage which he may do to said preserve or the pheasants and property thereon, but all actions for such trespass shall be brought by such licensee.
