CHAPTER 378

AN ACT to create 347.45 (4) of the statutes, relating to prohibiting use or sale of regrooved or recut tires.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

347.45 (4) of the statutes is created to read:

347.45 (4) No person shall knowingly operate on any highway any vehicle on which any tire has been regrooved or recut or offer such tire for sale or exchange. This subsection shall not apply to regrooved or recut commercial vehicle tires which are designed and constructed in such a manner that regrooving or recutting is an acceptable and safe practice, nor does this subsection apply to regrooving or recutting done in a tire recapping process.
