CHAPTER 483

AN ACT to create 66.072 (5) of the statutes, relating to dissolving town sanitary districts upon creation of town utility districts.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.072 (5) of the statutes is created to read:

66.072 (5) (a) When any town board establishes a utility district under this section the board may also, if a town sanitary district is in existence for the town, dissolve said sanitary district in which case all assets, liabilities and functions of the sanitary district shall be taken over by the utility district.

(b) All functions performed by a sanitary district and assumed by a utility district under this subsection shall remain subject to regulation by the public service commission as if no transfer had occurred.

(c) If a sanitary district is located in more than one municipality, action under this section may be taken only upon approval of a majority of the members of the governing body of each municipality in which the sanitary district is located.
