## CHAPTER 49

AN ACT to create 161.08 (2) (d), (e) and (f) of the statutes, relating to controls on exempt narcotic preparations.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

161.08 (2) (d), (e) and (f) of the statutes are created to read:

161.08 (2) (d) That such preparation when sold in a retail establishment shall bear the name and address of such establishment on the im-

ment shall bear the name and address of such establishment on the immediate container of said preparation.

(e) That any person purchasing such preparation shall at the time of purchase present to the seller his correct name and address. The seller shall then record said name and address and the name and quantity of the product sold. The purchaser and the seller shall sign the record of this transaction. The giving of a false name or false address by the purchaser shall be prima facie evidence of obtaining a narcotic drug by fraud and deceit and deceit.

(f) That no person shall purchase more than 8 ounces of such preparation within a 48-hour period without the authorization of a physician, dentist or veterinarian and that no more than 8 ounces may be in the possession of any person, other than a physician, dentist, veterinarian or pharmacist, at any time without the authorization of a physician, dentist or veterinarian.
