CHAPTER 91

- AN ACT to amend 253.40 of the statutes, relating to the place for keeping copies of judgments and orders of branches Nos. 3 and 4 of the county court of Rock county.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

253.40 of the statutes is amended to read:

253.40 Except in branches Nos. 3 and 4 of the Rock county court, every county judge in this state shall maintain in his office the books, papers and records of the county court at the county seat of the county in which he holds his office, which office and the books, papers and records thereof shall at all reasonable times be open to access and inspection by any person having any business therewith except as otherwise provided by law. *** Originals of judgments or orders made pursuant to county court jurisdiction, *** of branches Nos. 3 and 4 of the Rock county court in Beloit, *** shall be kept at the county seat.
