CHAPTER 149

AN ACT to create 38.08 (4) (dm) and 40.30 (17m) of the statutes, relating to permitting school boards to set school hours.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 38.08 (4) (dm) of the statutes is created to read:

38.08 (4) (dm) To establish rules scheduling the hours of each school day during which school shall be in session and may differentiate between the various grades of elementary and high school in setting such school hours schedule.

SECTION 2. 40.30 (17m) of the statutes is created to read:

40.30 (17m) The board may establish rules scheduling the hours of each school day during which school shall be in session and may differentiate between the various grades of elementary and high school in setting such school hours schedule.
