CHAPTER 15

- AN ACT to renumber 20.140 (5); and to create 20.140 (5) (b) of the statutes, relating to the Wisconsin exhibit at the New York World's Fair, and making an appropriation.
- The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 20.140 (5) of the statutes is renumbered 20.140 (5) (a).

SECTION 2. 20.140 (5) (b) of the statutes is created to read:

20.140 (5) (b) On the effective date of this paragraph (1965) a nonlapsible appropriation of \$50,000 for the purposes of continuing the Wisconsin pavilion during the 2nd year of the World's Fair, employing a resident manager to supervise the Wisconsin pavilion, Wisconsin exhibits and the world's largest cheese exhibit and 2 attendants, promotional releases and literature, providing a central rotunda information unit, and maintenance of the existing display areas. SECTION 3. This bill is declared to be an emergency appropriation bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the requirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
