CHAPTER 173

AN ACT to create 66.99 (3c) of the statutes, relating to the coverage of public personnel under the federal old age, survivors and disability insurance system.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact a follows:

66.99 (3c) of the Wisconsin statutes is created to read:

66.99 (3c) Effective April 1, 1966, with the exception of the exclusions provided by sub. (4a) the only exclusions covering positions not under a retirement system which shall be in effect under the state-federal agreement pursuant to action taken under sub. (2) shall be those exclusions which are mandatory under federal law. This provision shall not apply to any retirement system created by ch. 155 or 201, laws of 1937, as amended.
