CHAPTER 198

AN ACT to repeal and recreate 101.315 (1) (b) of the statutes, relating to definition of land surveying.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

101.315 (1) (b) of the statutes is repealed and recreated to read:

101.315 (1) (b) The term "land surveying" within the meaning and intent of this section means any service comprising the determination of the location of land boundaries and land boundary corners; the preparation of maps showing the shape and area of tracts of land and their subdivisions into smaller tracts; the preparation of maps showing the layout of roads, streets and rights of way of same to give access to smaller tracts; and the preparation of official plats, or maps, of said land in this state.
