CHAPTER 202

AN ACT to create 59.516 of the statutes, relating to personal signature and seal of a registered land surveyor required to entitle a map, plat or survey or other document of land surveying to be filed or recorded with the register of deeds.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

59.516 of the statutes is created to read:

59.516 REQUIRED SIGNATURE AND SEAL ON SURVEY DOCUMENT FOR FILING OR RECORDING. It is unlawful for the register of deeds of any county or any proper public authority to file or record any map, plat, survey or other document within the definition of land surveying, which does not have impressed thereon, and affixed thereto, the per-

sonal signature and seal of a registered land surveyor under whose responsible charge the map, plat, survey or other document was prepared. This section does not apply to any deed, contract or other recordable document prepared by an attorney.
