CHAPTER 207

AN ACT to amend 23.10 (2) of the statutes, relating to boards of appointment for county conservation wardens.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

23.10 (2) of the statutes is amended to read:

23.10 (2) Whenever the county board of any county shall by resolution authorize authorizes the appointment of county conservation wardens, and shall fix fixes the number of the same, it shall be the duty of the county judge chairman of the county board, district attorney, and county clerk, acting as a board of appointment, to select the persons for such positions and certify their names to the state conservation commission which shall, if in its judgment such persons are competent and efficient, issue to them commissions as county conservation wardens. Such wardens shall have, within their county, have all the powers and perform the duties of conservation wardens but. Their compensation shall be fixed by the county board in the resolution authorizing their appointment and be paid out of the county treasury.
