CHAPTER 208

AN ACT to amend 29.09 (12) of the statutes, permitting issuance of fishing and hunting licenses, to certain citizens of foreign countries.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

SECTION 1. 29.09 (12) of the statutes is amended to read:

29.09 (12) Fishing licenses and, small game hunting licenses and deer hunting licenses shall be issued at resident fees by the commission and by the county clerks to any student or to any member of the armed forces of the United States applying therefor, who exhibits proof that he is in active service with such armed forces and that he is stationed in Wisconsin or that he is a registered full-time undergraduate student in residence of a college or university, public or private, located in this state and offering a bachelor's degree or is a citizen of a foreign country temporarily residing in this state while attending a Wisconsin high school or an agricultural short course at the university of Wisconsin.

SECTION 2. This bill is declared to be an emergency bill, recommended by the joint committee on finance, in accordance with the requirements of section 16.47 (2) of the statutes.
