CHAPTER 214

AN ACT to create 39.015 of the statutes, relating to the creation of the office of deputy state superintendent of public instruction.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

39.015 of the statutes is created to read:

39.015 STATE SUPERINTENDENT; DEPUTY. The state superintendent shall appoint a deputy state superintendent who shall serve at the pleasure of the state superintendent. Such person may be appointed outside the classified service but subject to s. 16.274. The deputy shall perform such duties as are prescribed by the state superintendent. The state superintendent may designate the deputy or another departmental employe as his representative on any board, committee, commission, council or other body on which the state superintendent is required to serve, except for membership on the university board of regents, the co-ordinating committee for higher education and the state college board of regents. In the absence or disability of the superintendent, the deputy may do and perform all the acts provided by statute to be performed by the superintendent and the superintendent shall be responsible for all acts of his deputy. The deputy shall take and file the official oath of office.
