## CHAPTER 241

AN ACT to amend 66.901 (5a) of the statutes, relating to the confirmation of certain municipal elected officers as participating employes under the Wisconsin retirement fund.

The people of the state of Wisconsin, represented in senate and assembly, do enact as follows:

66.901 (5a) of the statutes is amended to read:

66.901 (5a) Any elected official of any participating municipality other than the state who prior to January 1, 1961 1965, had been a participating employe of that municipality, and who became an elected official of that munincipality prior thereto, and who, notwithstanding the failure to make the election required by sub. (5) (i), continued during all of said service as a participating employe and as an elected official to make normal contributions, shall be deemed to have so elected prior to his assumption of office if the written election required by sub. (5) (i) is received by the fund not later than August 31, 1961 1965, and his rights and credits as a participating employe under said fund will thereupon be ratified and confirmed.
